
AATi Recommended Installation Guidelines for fixing into concrete.

- 1. Ensure surface is sound and level.
- 2. Make good any worn or damaged areas with Ardex repair mortar (or similarly approved).
- 3. Make sure the recess is 1mm oversized than the Antislip Disc.
- 4. The Disc should be set 1mm higher than the surrounding surface.
- 5. Both the recess and the Disc should be free from grease and dirt etc.
- 6. Ensure the underside of the Disc is abraded.
- 7. Apply a layer of appropriate bedding compound such as Marfix or approved bedding compound to be spread out evenly to cover the underside of the Disc.
- 8. Place the Disc into position.
- 9. There should be a small amount of Marfix adhesive oozing out the sides which indicates enough has been used to prevent water etc encroaching into the cavity.
- 10. Wipe clean any excess Marfix and leave to set as per manufactures instructions.
